- I understand that Camp St. John's staff and volunteers are not allowed to babysit or transport children at any time outside of regularly scheduled activities and programs. If the staff member is related to the camper, that staff member will be allowed to transport the camper before and after camp as long as that staff member is listed in the above designated area.

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Statement of Authorization

1. My child has permission to be transported by the transportation services selected by Camp St. John's for field trips, and other events (Transportation: First Student – local trips, US Coachways – long distance trips)

If the parent/guardian is unable to be reached, the child's emergency contact will be notified. It is the responsibility of the parent/guardian to ensure the child is picked up as soon as possible.
4. In the case your child or anyone in the household develops a communicable disease; please keep your child home from camp. If the disease is later discovered, please notify camp administration within 24 hours
5. My signature below authorizes the management and staff of Camp St. John's to act according to their best judgment in the event of a medical emergency. I the parent/guardian grant permission for emergency medical treatment by a rescue squad, licensed physician, and/or hospital or emergency service. Any action taken will be in the best interest of the child and will be communicated to the parent/guardian as soon as possible. **In the unlikely event your child is to be taken to the hospital for any reason please indicate the preferred hospital here: _____** *If you do not list a preferred hospital, in the case of emergency your child will be taken to Baystate Hospital.*
6. The parent/guardian will ensure the child has **sunscreen** for self-application for protection for the sun's harmful rays
7. The parent/guardian will ensure the child comes to camp with a water bottle each day in order to help prevent heat exhaustion, etc. (Campers will be able to use the water fountain to refill their bottles throughout the day, *if refillable*)
8. The parent/guardian authorizes the self-application of insect repellent.

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Behavior Agreement

At Camp St. John's we take the safety, security, and happiness of your child very seriously. We want every day to be fun, exciting, and invigorating for them. We need your child to help us in that by following some very simple rules while on the premises of St. John's Congregational Church and in the care of our camp staff members. Please review these rules with your child/children prior to their arrival at camp.

- I will have fun, but consider my safety and the safety of others around me while doing so
- I will listen to all staff members and follow directions the first time given
- I will not touch anyone's belongings without permission
- I will not fight, hit, verbally, or otherwise abuse those around me
- I will use my inside voice at all times while in the building
- I will use appropriate language at all times. This means I will not swear, make negative remarks about anyone, use harmful words toward people, or any other verbal abuse.
- I will remain in the presence of a camp counselor or staff member at all times and will not run off on my own **for any reason.**

I understand that by not following these rules I can be suspended from the program, and my parent/guardian will not receive a refund as a result. All incidents will be handled on a 3 incident system with the exception of fighting. Campers who engage with their peers in a physical altercation will receive an immediate 1-day suspension from camp. All other incidents will be handled as follows:

1. Verbal warning
2. Written Warning/Parent Meeting
3. 1-Day suspension

At the camp director's discretion, campers that receive 3 written warnings during a session may be asked to leave the program for the remainder of the session.

Camp St. John's Age Requirements

Camp St. John's is open to kids/youth ages 6-16. Campers will be separated into the following age groups:

- 6-8 years of age
- 9-12 years of age
- 13-16 years of age
- 17 years of age (Junior Counselor)

Documents Needed for Age Verification

- Child's **ORIGINAL** Birth Certificate
- Immunization Record Signed by Primary Care Physician
